DEADLINE

Scholarship applications and required documentation must be received by the close of business **Friday, March 30, 2012**. Incomplete or late applications will **NOT** be considered.

TYPE AND ELIGIBILITY FOR SCHOLARSHIPS

The Association of Government Accountants (AGA) New York Capital Chapter is pleased to offer:

Up to two \$500 academic scholarships for **full-time or part-time study for 2012-2013**

- Applicant must be an AGA member or a family member (spouse, child or grandchild) of this Chapter for the 2012-2013 membership year and
- Scholarship must be applied toward undergraduate study in a financial management academic discipline*
- Candidate must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of (3.0) on a 4.0 scale.

*This includes disciplines such as accounting, auditing, budgeting, business administration, economics, finance, information technology and public administration.

CRITERIA FOR AWARD

The **Academic Scholarships** will be awarded on the basis of the candidate's potential for making a meaningful contribution to public financial management. Academic achievement prior to application is an indication of potential for successful study, but is not the only criteria that will be considered in awarding these scholarships. The following are required:

1. All scholarship candidates must include a list of three referral contacts. The list must contain: name, phone, email, and referral context (professor, employer, AGA member, guidance counselor). One referral **MUST** be an AGA member.
2. All scholarship candidates must submit a completed application form.
3. Official college academic transcript in a sealed envelope (sent directly from school)
